- P.1 Born Beast Beast Banks, Kendal, bought house built by Howie & Sons - £425. Cabinetmaker at Arthur W Simpsons.
- P.2 Earnings. War declared. Sent to Roe's at Woodford working on Ansons.
- P.3 Lodgings in Whalley Bridge, transferred to work on Flying boats at Troutbeck Bridge.
- P.4 Putting in flying controls in Sunderlands, test flights.
- P.6 Putting automatic controls in.
- P.7 Built house on Oxenholme Lane 1947.
- P.8 Moved to Oxenholme, kept hens, worked at JJ Smith's coach works, built cattle trucks for Barnes & Nelson. Went to work at Organ works, Aynam Road.
- P.9 Organ works went under, went back to cabinetmaking – self employed.
- P.10 Making grandmother clock.
- P.11 Music.
