At 15, Father became vicar of St. Thomas's Kendal. Attended Kendal High School.

Sister Enid started Brownies at St. Thomas's about 1953 - met in Mission Hall on Sandes Avenue.
- P.6 Sunday School concerts and Brownie concerts.  
Two entrances to St. Thomas's Church.  
Clergymen's hats.  
Girls' bible class/prayer meeting.  
Missionary would stay overnight at vicarage.  
Services/Sunday School.
- P.7 Venues of Sunday Schools  
Bible class at vicarage Sunday afternoons.  
Sunday School party at Christmas; outing to Tarn Hows by charabanc, singing psalms.  
Comparison with modern services.  
Parishioners - Dr and Mrs Cockhill; Miss Belsham; Miss Gooch.
